## There is Only One True God

"Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable."

Isaiah 40:28 NKJV

What comes into your mind when you think about God? Do you imagine a grandfatherly person with a long beard and flowing white robes? Does He seem more like the great big vending machine in the sky or a religious genie who is at your bidding? Or is it more comforting to see Him as a lonely deity who desperately needs companionship? These conceptions are utterly false for the Bible teaches that God is the holy Creator of the universe who is infinite and triune in the essence of His being (Ps.145:3; Is.57:15; 2 Cor.13:14).

Many people deny God's existence because "science" has supposedly disproven the Bible. Despite the consensus of academia, there is compelling evidence for God in the grandeur of the cosmos and the intricate design of life. The cell's nanotechnology and the complex information systems programmed into the DNA code testify to the existence of an Intelligent Designer (Ps.19:1; 139:13-16; Rom.1:20).

The personal identity of this all-wise Designer and what He is like has been disclosed to mankind through the Bible. God's revelation of Himself in the Holy Scriptures is a reliable source for understanding His character and nature because it is a compilation of historical documents written by eyewitnesses during the lifetimes of others who saw the events transpire. The Bible reports miraculous events that fulfilled specific prophecies and claims to be of divine origin, rather than human (Acts 1:3; 2 Tim.3:16; 2 Pet.1:20-21).

God's existence and the veracity of His Word has tremendous bearing upon our lives because His will as recorded in the Bible is absolute truth. By definition, truth is that which corresponds to reality as perceived by God Who is Ultimate Reality. In other words, truth is that which is consistent with the character and nature of God as revealed in the Bible (Ps.119:105; Jn.17:17; Rom.11:33-12:2).

Falsehood corrupts who God is either by denying that He exists or by saying that He is something other than He has shown Himself to be. Atheism teaches that God is not, agnosticism claims that God is not knowable, deism says that God is not interested, pantheism believes that God is everything and everything is God, and panentheism says that we are inside of God (Ex.20:1-6; Is.40:12-26; Acts 17:22-32).

Theism teaches that there is not only a God but that He is infinitely and intimately invested in His creation and upholds it in accordance with His immutable essence and the all-glorious majesty of Who He is. The God of the Bible is all-powerful and miraculously intervenes in the lives of people. He knows everything and is everywhere at the same time being unlimited by the time-space continuum. God is also all-loving because every individual is a person for whom Christ shed His royal blood as payment for their rebellion against the KING of kings (Ps.90:2; Col.1:16-20; Heb.1:1-4).

If we desire to understand what God is like, then we need to look nowhere else than to the Person of the Lord Jesus Christ for "in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily" (Col.2:9; Jn.1:14). May your life proclaim the majesty of the Maker in and through a personal relationship with the one true and living God, Jesus Christ. By grace alone through faith alone for the glory of God alone!

## "Understanding Biblical Creation"

(Evolution/Millions of Years is a Lie)

Does this sound familiar? "The cosmos began as a result of the big bang about 20 billion years ago. The solar system eventually formed and the Sun came into existence about 10 billion years ago. A hot molten blob which would be earth took shape 9.5 billion years ago. Water formed after the earth cooled 8.8 billion years ago. The oceans were the site of the earliest life-forms and by natural selection along with mutations, different kinds of life arose over the course of millions of years. Over time ape-like creatures evolved into modern man." The preceding is commonly understood as the explanation for the origin of the universe and life on Earth. Despite the publicity it receives in the media, the consensus of academia, and the general assumption of townspeople, evolution is a fairy tale better explained as the pagan religion of the modern era.

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth" (Genesis 1:1). "For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day" (Exodus 20:11). The Bible teaches that God is the Creator Who spoke all things into existence out of nothing just several thousand years ago. In the six 24 hour days of creation is found the origin of time, space, matter, earth, plants, the celestial bodies, marine life, animals including dinosaurs, and people.

The critical issue between these two competing views for understanding origins is this: whose starting point is more credible? The next time you hear someone waxing eloquent about billions of years, politely ask, "Were you there to see that happen?" If they respond similarly, you could honestly say you were not but that you know someone who was and He recorded the historical details in a book called the Bible. Should we therefore rely upon the changing opinions of fallible scientists who do not know everything and who were not there in the beginning to see everything transpire or should we rely upon the infallible Word of the all-powerful God Who does not change, Who knows everything, and Who gave us an eyewitness account of the origin of the universe? Which of these is a more credible starting point?

The creation/evolution debate is oftentimes viewed as a conflict between religion and science. This is a false assertion because the interpretation of the scientific data observed in the present is determined by the scientist's presupposed belief about the past. Even ardent evolutionists have religious beliefs that are tenaciously held on to. Their faith is in the millions/billions of years needed for the evolutionary progression of life. It is through this lens that the evolutionist views the world and understands things like fossils, dinosaurs, the age of rocks, the so-called races, and the similar characteristics of animal life.

Biblical creation stands upon the absolute authority of the Word of God beginning from the very first verse. The meaning of everything is directly tied to its origin. The purpose and sanctity of life, marriage, ethics, and why mankind needs a Savior are directly tied to the book of Genesis. Western civilization's decline and virtually every social ill can be traced back to the Church's willingness to compromise the truth and bow to the lie of evolutionary philosophy. May the Lord raise up a new reformation in His Church so that spiritual revival may come in this era of history for the praise, honor, and glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ!

<u>Sermon Introduction</u> — "Take a journey with me as we travel together back in time to the ancient Roman Empire..." Robert Wolgemuth, in "The Most Important Place on Earth: What a Christian Home Looks Like and How to Build One", shares how he and his almost-eight-year-old granddaughter viewed a massive piece of art in a Charlotte, NC museum. It was Jean-Leon Gerome's 1863 piece called "Early Christian Martyrs in the Coliseum at Rome." Personally, I first came across this piece of art myself at Northern Grace Youth Camp in WI in a hundred-year-old copy of Foxe's Book of Martyrs which I later paid my oldest son something like \$20 to read it cover-to-cover at about 10 years old.

### "Ministry Training Begins at Home"

"As you know how we exhorted, and comforted and charged every one of you, as a father does his own children, that you would walk worthy of God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory."

1 Thessalonians 2:11-12 NKJV

My family and I travel across our country ministering in churches, camps, and conferences throughout the year. The aging demographics we observe in many congregations present challenges to the sustainability of American grace churches and our impact on the foreign mission field. Radical changes must be made by churches and families moving forward as co-champions of the next generation. Both must understand that ministry training does not begin when young people arrive on campus at Grace Christian University, Berean Bible Institute, or any other school, but well ahead of time during the formative years of life right at home with dad and mom (1 Thes.2:11-12).

In *The Gathering Storm: Secularism, Culture, and the Church*, Dr. Albert Mohler issues a bold challenge for the church to be deliberate in engaging the storm gathering over the coming generations. Intentional ministry training begins at home in three poignant ways:

- 1. Christian parents [and grandparents] must view church as the highest and utmost priority for their family's weekly schedule. A secularized culture idolizes athletic prowess, and many Christians buy into this due to the perception that incessant sports activities (even on Sunday) will increase their child's eventual college entrance application. Should they really be surprised when their investment into the traveling team captures the heart of the next generation at the expense of a church which they have never really known in the first place? As the pillar and ground of doctrinal truth, the ministry of the local church should be paramount to the weekly routine and rhythm of biblical family life (1 Tim.3:15).
- 2. Christian parents [and grandparents] need to be serious about the effects of technology, screen time, and social media. Such gadgets and platforms are worldview-shaping influencers in the lives of young people whose impressionable minds are susceptible to the diabolically insidious nature of deception (Col.2:8). The formative years of youth should not be squandered but redirected toward developing a comprehensive and therefore biblical Christian worldview. Along with this, cultivating practical ministry skills by learning how to read robust literature like missionary biographies, playing musical instruments, and building daily work ethic through being industrious, diligent, and disciplined is a priority of home-based ministry training (Eph.5:15-17).
- 3. Christian parents [and grandparents] must endeavor to fill their homes with the fragrance of the gospel. More important than adorning the physical house is filling it with "the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ" and the intangible virtues of faith, hope, and love (Pr.24:3-4; Phil.1:11). Training the next generation for ministry leadership begins right at home through spiritual disciplines like family worship time, Scripture memorization, and singing the praises of Him who alone is worthy of all praise because of who He is and what He has done in Christ Jesus.

## "The Glory of Motherhood"

"Blessed is every one who fears the LORD, who walks in His ways. Your wife shall be like a fruitful vine in the very heart of your house, your children like olive plants all around your table. Behold, thus shall the man be blessed who fears the LORD."

Psalm 128:1, 3-4 NKJV

As image-bearers of the Creator, women have been blessed by God with the stewardship of being wives and mothers (Gen.1:27-28). Perhaps the most controversial truth of the irreplaceable nature of marriage is that God's biblical design upholds the glory of motherhood. Radical feminism and the Marxist agenda of woke paganism are in rebellion against the beauty, nobility, and glory of being a wife and mother, which the Holy Scriptures affirm with the utmost honor and dignity in the sight of God (Psa. 128:3; Pro. 31:10-31; 1 Tim.2:15; 2 Tim.1:5; 3:15; Titus 2:3-5).

Regardless of what the sirens of the age assert, only biological women have children, and God's Word lauds the blessedness of the fruitful womb (Psa. 127:3-5; 139:13; Mal. 2:15). The irreplaceable nature of marriage builds civilization, fills this world with image-bearing worshippers of the one true and living God, and advances the cause of Christ to the ends of the earth beginning right at home.

While on a ministry adventure trip, some time ago, a young couple invited me to their home for supper. After we enjoyed a hearty meal of chicken enchiladas, Joe and Heather (not their real names) shared about their upbringing and back story. It turns out that they had been born and raised in New England before meeting in college. Joe had been reared in a type of Eastern Orthodox religious tradition but Heather was brought up atheist believing in "science" (evolutionary naturalism). She explained that her communications major trained her to articulate the Marxist ideologies they were indoctrinated into at this progressively liberal college out east.

After getting married, Joe and Heather moved to a city in the Pacific Northwest that is notorious for being a bastion of far-left secularism because she described this as just what young liberals do. **Through the course of events, God providentially used the so-called "peaceful protests" of BLM to beckon to their hearts.** By this time, they were expecting a baby and questioned whether or not a city where a stack of Bibles lit on fire in the street was the kind of place they really wanted to raise their daughter. In fact, Joe even came across the charred remains of a New Testament on a sidewalk and suffice it to say that he continued thinking deeply about the spiritual issues of life and death along with time and eternity. Complications with her pregnancy were used of the Lord to stir Heather's heart to take stock of the same. Not too long after that, they moved out of the city to a generally more sensible part of that same region of the country and purchased some property on the side of a mountain. Their homestead farm of sorts was a beautiful enclave nestled into that hillside with tremendous potential for carving out a flourishing family life. **Eventually they landed at a solid Bible-teaching church nearby where they were growing in grace and knowledge of their Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.** 

Their testimony was so beautiful and precious that I found myself getting teary-eyed, especially as Heather proceeded to share the aspirations of her heart. Despite being brought up as an atheist in a family steeped in evolution and college educated with a baccalaureate degree in communications, her heart's desire was to be a stay-at-home mom who intentionally trains her children in the pathways of truth and righteousness. I wholeheartedly affirmed this passion and encouraged her that whereas the world disparages such virtue in the name of merely being "barefoot and pregnant" which she incidentally was (expecting their second child), the Bible lauds the glory of motherhood. Further, I shared that despite whatever the world may say, she is building civilization right alongside her knight in shining armor for the glory, praise, and honor of Almighty God.

May the Lord raise up a multitude of women like Heather whose hearts desire is to champion the glory of motherhood and therefore invest the stewardship of their gifts, talents, and abilities to advance the cause of Christ to the ends of the earth…beginning right at home!

## "Hell is for Real"

Heaven is indeed for real but so also is hell. It is also known as the "lake of fire" and is a horrible place that sinners will be banished to on Judgment Day because of their subtle rebellion, outright wickedness, "good-enough" moralism, self-righteous living, or legalistic religion. This gift of love was given on behalf of vile, wicked, rebellious, moralistic, and self-righteous sinners who are wholly deserving of God's undiluted wrath and judgment in the horrors and outer darkness of eternal hellfire.

Every world religion requires its adherents to pay homage to its deity in the prescribed manner by bringing forth the necessary sacrificial offerings or through legalistic observance of rites, ceremonies, and rituals that are believed to be required in order to merit favor with the divine. What separates Biblical Christianity from the rest of the pack is that it is the only belief system in which God Himself in His holiness and unbridled merciful lovingkindness provided the sacrifice needed to satisfy the demands of His righteous justice. Not only did He provide it but He Himself is the ultimate sacrifice in the Person of the Lord Jesus Christ, the God-Man. Beyond this, He offers to sinners everywhere the gift of total forgiveness of sins and eternal spiritual life and is received by faith alone in Christ.

**God Himself** accomplishing for people what they could not do for themselves and freely giving the results thereof is what the grace of God is all about. It is this very thing that separates Biblical Christianity from the false-Christian cults and religious belief systems of the world.

There are more than 7 billion people on Earth, over 4 billion do not claim to be Christian, and more than 2.7 billion are totally unreached with the light of the gospel of Jesus Christ. Millions in the world today will die in their sins and go straight to hell without ever hearing of the love of God in Jesus Christ. Everyone deserves to hear the gospel at least once and it is therefore incumbent upon born again Christians to possess an evangelistic urgency and passion for the missionary mandate of the Church both here and abroad.

<u>Introduction</u> — In "We Will Not Be Silenced: Responding Courageously to Our Culture's Assault on Christianity",

Dr. Erwin Lutzer of Chicago's Moody Memorial Church speaks to the urgency of what God has called us to "in Christ Jesus." ## Going Deeper → "The Grace Message is Jesus Christ"

"To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus."

Colossians 1:27-28 NKJV

Back in the early 1990s, Ed & Linda Bedore served as missionaries with Things to Come Mission at a Bible and Ministry Training School in Embu, Kenya. This experience prepared them to spearhead the launching of a similar school in Wisconsin, Berean Bible Institute, where I completed the bulk of my undergraduate training for ministry.

As a newly married man, I was full of youthful vigor and ministry ambition. I was very familiar with God's Word, rightly divided, and this dispensational understanding of Scripture compelled me to embark upon the endeavor of "making all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery" (Eph.3:9). Dr. Bedore was a very wise man having a breadth of experience before and after he and his wife were saved later in life. He knew how to come alongside and redirect the passion of this young buck, along with many others, from being preoccupied with mere Bible knowledge to a Pauline balance between the doctrinal and practical truths of Scripture.

I often left Dr. Bedore's *Practical Dispensational Theology* classes feeling humbled by how little I really knew God's Word; but one time, he arrested my attention with a statement that jarred me like never before. During a break between classes, we were discussing the distinctive nature of Pauline doctrine when he deliberately distilled the conversation into the heart of the matter by declaring with resolute biblical conviction: "*The Grace Message is Jesus Christ.*" In so doing, he reminded me that Paul's gospel is preeminently "the preaching of Jesus Christ" and that he did it "according to the revelation of the mystery" (Rom.16:25). The focus of my heart and ministry were therefore encouraged to be upon Jesus Christ and living in total dependency upon Him and the Word of God to the praise of His glory.

After two decades of serving in churches, camps, and conferences across America and visiting foreign mission fields, I wholeheartedly affirm Dr. Bedore's distilled wisdom. The heart of the Grace Message or Paul's gospel is indeed Jesus Christ Himself according to at least three preeminent truths.

- 1. Preaching Jesus Christ as Almighty Creator is Foundational to the Grace Message Col.1:16 cf. Acts 17:22-31. From everlasting to everlasting, there is one true and living God who reigns in majesty supreme. God the Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, is the Holy One of Heaven who has revealed the glorious triune nature of the Godhead through the handiwork of His exquisitely designed creation (Ps.19:1-4; Rom.1:20). Dr. Bedore had a passion for the majesty and magnitude of the Creator and he deliberately mentored us to champion this truth by equipping us with the tools of convictional leadership needed in our generation (2 Tim.2:2; Titus 2:6-8).
- **2.** Preaching Jesus Christ as Merciful Savior is Central to the Grace Message Col.1:13-14, 20 cf. Acts 13:38-39; 26:18. The blazing center of God's glory vested in the Person and finished work of the Lord Jesus Christ is the heart of the Paul's gospel of grace. At Calvary, Christ Himself bore the undiluted wrath of the Father on behalf of rebel sinners, and His royal blood provided redemption for all mankind. Salvation today is received as a free gift of grace through faith alone in Christ to the praise of His glory (Rom.3:21-26; 4:5; 2 Cor.4:3-4; Eph.1:13-14; 2:8-9). Dr. Bedore had a passion for evangelism and faithfully taught us to reach out with the good news of salvation so that lost sinners could be saved by having their sins forgiven, be justified through Christ's righteousness imputed to their account, and therefore pass from spiritual death to life in Christ Jesus for the glory of God (Rom.5:1; Titus 3:5).
- 3. Preaching Jesus Christ as Exalted Head is Functional to the Grace Message Col.1:18 cf. Acts 20:28-32. The practical reality of Paul's Gospel is that Jesus Christ is Lord and therefore in charge of the Church, which is His Body. Christ loved the Church and gave Himself for it so that He could give Himself to it in order to magnify His glory in and through His people (Gal.2:20). This indwelling life of Christ is experienced as they live in surrender to Christ by presenting their bodies unto Him as a living sacrifice day by day (Rom.12:1). It was for this reason that Dr. Bedore rephrased C.T. Studd's famous declaration to: "Only one life, 'twill soon be past. Only what's done 'in Christ' will last." All his students remember that Dr. Bedore famously had a passion for Romans chapter five as it was not uncommon for him to take us to the first several verses in virtually any given class period. This text was significant to him because of its relevance to tapping into God's grace needed for daily living for the glory of His name amidst the adverse circumstances of life (Rom.5:1-5).

Consider this: What is at the forefront of your heart & mind & therefore the all-consuming passion of your life?

#### <u>Historical & Biblical Context</u>

Apostle Paul's letter to the Romans is the magnum opus of his epistles as it is the longest and most comprehensive exposition of Christian doctrine in Holy Scripture. The "righteousness of God" is the theme and is systematically unfolded through detailed explanation of how Almighty God can justify depraved sinners and still uphold the justice of His throne and absolute holiness. The biblical doctrine of the penal substitutionary atonement of Christ is the answer at the heart of this book which is therefore the foundation to righteous and sanctified living in an ungodly world hell-bent on rebellion against the Creator and Redeemer of mankind.

## "Living in Gospel Triumph Every Day"

(Experiencing Victory Over Depression)

"You seem rather happy to be from [around here]," said the grumpy old man while we waited in line. My response to his comment was also forthright, "Jesus Christ has transformed my life!" The man explained that his disappointment resulted from the community's failure to deliver in his pursuit of happiness.

This scenario is not unique to that locale but is played out worldwide being the human condition. Long faces, bad attitudes, & depressed hearts that seem to plague that area though cannot be cured through simply changing circumstances. Relief from stressful situations can help temporarily but victory over depression is possible despite the circumstances of life. Being anchored in objective truth, having a thankful heart, humble servanthood, & walking in dependent trust upon Christ is the only way to experience lasting victory over adversity & depression.

Truth often conflicts with our emotions & circumstances so we must respond by faith in the absolute reality of God's Word, the Bible. Emotions are good servants but lousy masters. They are like a train caboose that is meant to follow behind the engine, hoppers, & box cars. Our hearts must be driven by the mighty engine of God's Word in order to experience victory over depression. "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path" (Ps.119:105 NKJV).

Embracing an attitude of gratitude by rejecting criticism & despair is also key in this battle. We live in a broken world but God is still in control. He allows adversity into our lives because He has an eternal plan from which He is working. His people should be unrelenting optimists because He is the One who is good & great even when life hurts. Anything better than eternity in the burning fires of hell is a cause for rejoicing. "In everything give thanks for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you (I Thes.5:18 NKJV).

Being a humble servant offering help wherever needed & therefore refusing selfish arrogance is critical to enjoying victory. Depressed people are usually proud, insecure, & self-centered. Rather than saying, "I am NOT gonna do that!", ask instead, "How can I help?" "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, & to give His life as a ransom for many." (Mark 10:45 NKJV).

Walking daily in dependent trust on God & rejecting self-reliance is also key to experiencing victory over depression. We do not have the wisdom, courage, or power needed to move forward out of any pit of despair we may find ourselves in. Jesus Christ is always THE Answer to everything. "Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding" (Prov. 3:5 NKJV).

Freedom, victory, & triumph are available to everyone & can be displayed on your face despite the adverse circumstances of life. It begins by turning your eyes away from self toward heaven to behold the all-glorious majesty of GOD's holiness. Condemned before Him, may your heart be surrendered at Calvary where the Lord Jesus Christ died for sinners & rose again. Trust Him today & live! "Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift" (2 Cor.9:15 NKJV)!

## "Identifying the War of Worldviews" Colossians 2:6-10

<u>Introduction</u> – There is a cosmic battle being waged between the All-Glorious Kingdom of Almighty GOD & the Satanic Regime of Darkness that is dominated by the demonic forces of evil. This cosmic battle is vying for the hearts and minds and souls of men, women, boys, & girls among all nations worldwide. It is spiritual warfare between light & darkness, truth & falsehood, freedom & tyranny. It is an all-out war of worldviews that is wreaking havoc upon generations of professing Christians many of whom are ignorant, apathetic, and indifferent to the spiritual wreckage of secularism that is engulfing our culture. On the other hand, what is going to be the testimony of your life? What say you?

#### Historical & Biblical Context

The ancient city of Colossae was about 100 miles east of Ephesus in the fertile Lycus River Valley of Asia Minor (modern day western Turkiye). This divinely inspired epistle of Apostle Paul was written to the Colossian church to exalt the preeminence of the Lord Jesus Christ as Sovereign Creator (of all things visible & invisible) & Supreme Head of the Church which is His Body. Gnosticism & Syncretism are heresies that were subverting the spiritual health & vitality of the church & family in Colossae. An intermingling of Jewish legalism, new age pagan spirituality, & Biblical Christianity produced an occasion that warranted the writing of this book. The all-glorious supremacy of the Deity of the Lord Jesus Christ & His vicarious sacrifice along with everything this means to the spiritual life, ministry, & stewardship responsibility of the Christian is central to this book.

Every challenge that we face in this generation has a single answer. Multitudes of church youth eventually leave because they are either not genuinely saved or they do not have a Biblical worldview. Many who are spiritually alive in Christ have minds that are more conformed to the world's priorities & value system than to the Word of God. Transformation of the heart and mind by God's Spirit as cultivated through the Christian worldview is something that every generation needs.

It is imperative that the Church equip believers for the ministry of transmitting the truth to the next generation. This begins at home with dad and mom instructing their children in the Word of God. Raising generations who understand what they believe, why they believe it, and know how to defend the faith against the skeptical questions of the day in the context of a secular culture that is increasingly hostile to the exclusive truth claims of Biblical Christianity should be the highest priority in every church and family.

There is hope for this generation because Almighty God ordains the ends and the means for the unfolding of His sovereign plan and eternal purpose for history. God's people have been entrusted with a duty-bound stewardship responsibility to advance the cause of Christ to the ends of the earth beginning right at home on the grass roots level. May church and family co-champion the dead serious urgency of this stewardship by investing this day in light of that day when our lives flash before our eyes and we give an account before the sovereign majesty of the KING of kings and LORD of lords who is worthy of all praise both now and forever. **Soli Deo Gloria!**

Ephesians 5:15-17

<u>Introduction</u> – The spirit of this age that says: "Carpe Diem. Seize the day, boys. Make your lives extraordinary." In contrast to this conventional wisdom of the world, we must "Seize the Day...for Jesus Christ: By Intentionally Pursuing Excellence...to the Praise of GOD's Glory."

**Biblical & Historical Context:** First century Ephesus was a world-famous city being the site of one of the wonders of the ancient world namely the temple of a pagan fertility goddess called Diana or Artemis. This cosmopolitan city was therefore full of people from all different walks of life around the world. Dense population, diversity of culture, and a dynamic tourist economy also meant an immense amount of depravity condensed into this city rife with sin, death, and darkness. ## "Building a Missionally-Engaged Christian Worldview"

"See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil.

Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord is."

Ephesians 5:15-17 NKJV

Being intentional in building a missionally-engaged Christian worldview rooted in Holy Scripture is the stewardship responsibility of the Church among all nations worldwide. The pressing urgency driving this pursuit is the blazing center of God's glory vested in the Person and finished work of Christ before whom contemporary culture is in utter rebellion. This depravity of a Romans 1 world is demonstrated by the rejection of moral restraint in the name of "social justice" and getting on "the right side of history." Despite the ungodly spirit of the age and come what may, God calls His people to boldly lead onward in ministry for such a time as this.

- 1. Intentionally Walking in Worldview Wisdom The biblical Christian worldview is founded upon the sufficiency of Scripture which is comprehensive in its scope, as there is no direction in which a person may figuratively travel where God's Word has not spoken (Ps.19:7-11; 2 Tim.3:16-17). Wisdom begins with reverence for Almighty God before whom strongholds against the exclusiveness of Christ are demolished (Pr.1:7; 2 Cor.10:3-5). Unless we are deliberate in building a worldview rooted in Scripture, our lives will unwittingly be deceived by falsehood such as postmodernism (no absolute truth), secular humanism (man is ultimate authority), moralistic therapeutic deism (God is a cosmic genie), and other baseline cultural narratives that are contrary to Christ and the Word of God (Col.2:8-10).
- 2. Intentionally Walking in Redemptive Stewardship Scripture teaches that Christ is the meaning and purpose of life before whom every knee will bow and every tongue will confess that He is worthy of all praise as King of kings and Lord of lords (Jn.1:1-14; Phil.2:5-11). Redemptive stewardship affirms that our time, treasure, and talent must be invested in eternity for there is coming a day of reckoning when our lives will flash before our eyes and we will give an account before God Himself at the Judgment Seat of Christ (1 Cor.3:10-15; 2 Cor.5:9-11). A wise man once asked the haunting question, Is what you're living for worth Christ dying for? Indeed, Only one life will soon be past, only what's done 'in Christ' will last.
- 3. Intentionally Walking in Missional Engagement Changing the world one heart and life at a time through cultural engagement begins with the salt and light moral back pressure of the Christian worldview in general but the transforming power of the gospel of God's grace in particular (2 Cor.4:3-6; Titus 2:11-14). Every man, woman, boy, and girl among all nations worldwide is a precious soul for whom the royal blood of Christ was shed but multitudes have never heard of the Living God and never will unless a new generation surrenders to God's call and is deliberate in building a missionally-engaged Christian worldview (Rom.10:14-15; 16:25-27; 1 Tim.2:3-4).


