← Looking Back

Prior to this tragedy last month, my family and I were amid a two-week ministry adventure trip to SD, NE/IA, & MO. The original Grace Family Conference in Tabor, SD was, once again, heavily attended with a total of 169 showing up throughout the weekend hosted by the saints of Grace Bible Church. My sermon, "Raising Warrior Poets & Maidens of Virtue" fit well with the Medieval dress up theme on Saturday night and will be uploaded to GFM's YouTube channel ASAP. Lakeview Bible Church in Carter Lake, IA (just outside of Omaha, NE) hosted us for several days en route to a weekend of ministry at St. Louis Bible Fellowship.

The day after Charlie Kirk's assassination, it was Patriot Day (9/11), and I was reading my One Year Bible while walking the church parking lot when a police officer drove by. After circling the building, he pulled into the parking lot and got out of his vehicle. This thirty-something year old young man was a veteran officer with a Catholic background and really struggling to find hope amid the tragedy. As he was looking for some encouragement, I opened my pocket Bible that once belonged to the late Dr. Eddie Bedore, founding director of Berean Bible Institute, when he served as a missionary in Kenya, East Africa. The text that I read aloud to this disillusioned officer, who regularly sees violence on the job, was **Isaiah 40:28-31.** While we walked through the Scripture, I drew connections to the cross of our Savior along with biblical manhood and pointed out that this is exactly what Charlie Kirk was doing as he called out young men and called them up to leadership, marriage, and family. During our conversation, my oldest son, Timothy, walked up and the officer cracked a joke about them receiving a phone call about a strange guy outside the church building. Even with

some levity, our conversation was sobering due to the urgency of our national crisis. Before going our separate ways, Timothy led in prayer for the officer with the hope that his heart was indeed genuinely encouraged. Please pray for him as Pastor Ken Sudduth reaches out to follow up with this law enforcement officer. **Thanks!**

Just days after Charlie Kirk's untimely death, we found ourselves in the St. Louis area ministering at the Fall Retreat/Picnic of Bible Fellowship before joining the saints for worship at their historic church building in the city. "Generational Faithfulness in a Pagan Culture" was my sermon from Daniel chapter one which focused on the dead serious urgency of family discipleship. It is already uploaded to GFM's YouTube channel along with several poignant excerpts that address this national tragedy. Many thanks to Pastor & Mrs. Rick Owsley and the saints for the opportunity to minister in Word and song as we gathered for the worship of Him who is worthy of all praise. Once again, thank you for upholding GFM in prayer especially amid travels.

After an extended trip, reentry back home can be a challenge. Unloading our van, unpacking bags, doing laundry, catching up on mail, bills, and grocery shopping takes some time. Perhaps the best part of being back home here in Indianapolis is sleeping in our own beds and reconnecting with one another as we reflect on the myriads of blessings throughout the recent ministry adventure. **There's no place like home!**

The former features several different speakers and is shaping up to rival the original GFC for attendance as word is getting out and people are inviting friends who have a heart for family discipleship. The latter will have Pastor Joel Finck and I speaking on the theme "Family, On Purpose! Intentionally Advancing the Cause of Christ Right at Home."

In MI, there will be a pre-conference luncheon for pastors & ministry leaders (& spouses) focused on "Parenting & Family Discipleship on Purpose!" with Terrah (& Oscar) Quesada. As the daughter of Chuck & Joy Befus, long time missionaries to Costa Rica with Grace Ministries Intl., she wrote a book called "Nine Kids, On Purpose" that recounts seven biblical principles that shaped their family's faith, purpose, and vision. Our prayer is that this seminar/workshop will not only introduce the heart and vision of the Befus family legacy but also equip God's servants with practical ministry skills to do similarly in their arenas of influence.
